The Invictus Games is an international sporting event for wounded, injured and ill servicemen and women, both active service members and veterans.

As one of the 11 sports being held, indoor rowing will be held on Monday 22 October at Quay Centre, Sydney Olympic Park.

Get involved

We need a team of enthusiastic and passionate volunteers to help us successfully deliver indoor rowing for the Invictus Games Sydney 2018 and make the Games a memorable and inspiring experience for all.

Rowing Australia is seeking Expressions of Interest from the rowing community who understand indoor rowing:

Technical Associate (6)

Assist in the fitting requirements of competitors in the lead up and day of competition.

- Prior to competition day, assist with the fitting of competitors to rowing machines under the guidance of Fitter and Engineer.
- On competition day, work as part of the fitting team changing over C2 machines to athlete specific requirements.
- Must understand C2 indoor rowers and;
- Must be available from 18 – 21 October to assist fitting and recording of competitor requirements.

Lane Officials (21)

On the day of competition each lane official will be allocated two machines 'lanes'. Each Lane Official will assist the smooth running of the event through:

- Ensuring the competitors are on the correct machine, set up and ready to race.
- Monitoring each competitor during each race.
- Manually recording distance for each race in their lanes.

Starter (1)

On the day of competition, start each race in conjunction with the VRA Technical Officials, and Lane Officials.

- Available Monday 22 October 7am – 4pm for competition.
- Available Sunday 21 October for Technical Meeting.
