



Junior Coaches: Expressions of Interest

Melbourne University Boat Club is seeking expressions of interest from passionate, knowledgeable and experienced Junior (aged 14-18) rowing coaches to lead the MUBC Academy program.

The Club:

Melbourne University Boat Club is a high performance club with masters', junior and club squad. The club has thriving Development squads feeding in to a growing High Performance section, with this being MUBC's priority area. The Academy program is a key foundation to the long run success of the High Performance objectives at MUBC.

The program:

The Academy program was started at the end of 2017 with the aim to *"develop healthy, mature and well-conditioned athletes capable of representing MUBC at major national and international events [such as HOOCR and HRR], and Australia at World and Olympic Championships"*. The program recruits Year 10s at the beginning of the calendar year and works – over 2.5 years - to prepare the athletes (with some or no previous rowing experience) to succeed in the sport - with rowers' senior careers being the priority. The success of the program is measured against the following areas:

1. Retention Junior-Senior
2. Performance during junior years
3. Performance as senior athletes
4. Percentage of athletes making Aus U23 and Senior teams
5. Welfare, wellbeing and satisfaction surveys

The roles:

MUBC is seeking to appoint up to 2 **paid** coaches to run and manage the Academy program as part of the broader performance coaching team. The role provides an excellent opportunity to lead a program as part of a high performance club, alongside other experienced and professional coaches. MUBC supports opportunities to develop one's own coaching both internally and externally, and the coaching team is supported by the club's Operations Manager.
