For [Division I](#) and [Division II](#) Colleges, the NCAA sets academic initial-eligibility standards that take into account your Grade Point Average (GPA), standardized test scores, core courses taken in high school and the grades earned in those core courses. You must also meet the unique acceptance requirements of the college you plan to attend, which may exceed NCAA standards.

CORE COURSES

16 core courses completed over 4 years from Years 9 - 12



GPA

Achieve a minimum 2.3 GPA for Division I or 2.2 for Division II Colleges



GRADUATE HIGH SCHOOL

Complete Years 9 – 12 in 4 years



AMATEUR STATUS

No financial payments or support by an organisation that is greater than necessary expenses



TESTS

Sit the SAT or ACT exam and earn a minimum score
(Div I: 980 or 75 and Div II: 1020 or 79 respectively).
