

US COLLEGE FACT SHEET

SCHOLARSHIP TYPES



Each academic year scholarships will be reviewed by the athletic department and your scholarship level can increase or decrease based on academic and athletic performance. If your College plans to reduce or not renew your aid, you must be notified in writing by July 1 and provided with an opportunity to appeal. In most cases, it is the Head Coach that decides who receives a scholarship, the scholarship amount and whether it will be renewed.



FULL RIDE SCHOLARSHIP
Covers major costs of attending college like tuition, room and board, books and course fees.



PARTIAL SCHOLARSHIP
Covers a portion of costs that can differ greatly from one student-athlete to another.



PREFERRED WALK-ON
Seat in the rowing program, but no financial assistance, at least for the first year.



RECRUITED WALK-ON
Interest from the coach, though no financial assistance and still need to earn a seat in the program through try outs.



UNRECRUITED WALK-ON
Qualify for academic admission to the College and plan to join the program through open try-outs.
