Competition experience as an oarswoman/oarsman is highly desirable. Candidates must possess or be able to obtain a Victorian Working With Children Card (Employment) and/or VIT Registration. It is also a condition of employment that Sports Coaches must have current Anaphylaxis Management Accreditation.

Remuneration will be in accordance with the Geelong Grammar School Salary Scale.
